## Planning your visit

Field trips to the library generally include a brief introduction to the library, a special story time, and a library tour. Visits typically last about 45 minutes.

If you want to bring a group to the Library for independent play and check out, and do not expect a formal program from a librarian, we still appreciate a courtesy call to prepare our staff for a group visit.
